SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

MISSION

To provide a scholarship program that will award scholarships annually to encourage and assist students who have a history of ministry efforts at Lakeside Church or through its ministries (e.g. missions) and who are committed to entering the Christian ministry vocationally or a closely related career field.

FUNDING

- All scholarships will be awarded from church scholarship funds.
- The scholarship program will be funded from gifts.

SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

- At least two members at large, one a member of the Elders Board (appointed by Elders Board)
- Youth Pastor

SCHOLARSHIPS

- Scholarships will range up to \$2,500 per person per year for undergraduate students with a max of 15,000 in total scholarship rewards per year. Additional funding may be available on an individual basis to be determined by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarships are given for one year. Scholarship recipients may reapply for an additional scholarship the following year (must reapply each year).
- Graduate/Seminary scholarships will range up to \$2,500 per year. Additional funding may be available on an individual basis to be determined by the Scholarship Committee.

APPLICANTS

- Must be actively involved in ministry at Lakeside Church, and, if selected to receive a scholarship, must be willing to attend Lakeside 101, the membership class at Lakeside Church. (Unless scholarship recipients are members of a congregation in the community where they attend college, they should be members of Lakeside Church.)
- Must plan to attend an accredited public or private college.
- Must be a full time student (12 Semester units or 16 Quarter units).
- Must be actively involved in ministry and be planning to pursue the Christian ministry or a ministry related career.

APPLICANTS SHOULD SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING BY JUNE 1, 2012 (March 15, 2013ff)

- Completed scholarship application.
- Official transcript (3.00 GPA Minimum).
- Statement of Faith (testimony and what you believe) maximum of 250 words typed.
- A 500-word typed essay that focuses on your current and past ministry efforts, and where you see yourself in terms of Christian ministry after you graduate from college; the essay should also address why this scholarship is important to your goals.
- List of all sources and value of financial support for the coming school year (include all scholarships, grants, and private support).
- Letters of recommendation:
 1. From a school official (principal, counselor, dean or teacher)
 2. From the Youth Pastor or Pastoral Staff
 3. From a Christian adult or employer, etc. (other than a parent).

REAPPLYING APPLICANTS MUST:

1. Fill out a new application.
2. Submit current Transcripts.
3. Write a new 500-Word essay about their year and how he/she has moved toward future goals.
4. No need for a new statement of faith (by reapplying you confirm your support of the beliefs that were cited on the original statement of faith).
5. One letter of recommendation from a principal, counselor, Dean or teacher that describes the last 12 months of your life and growth—spiritually, mentally, emotionally, etc).
